Clarification with regard to provisions of Corporate Social Responsibility under section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013. This Policy has been formulated under the above provisions of the Act and shall be applicable to all CSR initiatives and activities undertaken by the Company, for the benefit of different segments of society.

OBJECTIVE

This Policy shall be read pursuant to the provisions of Section 135 of the Companies Act 2013, Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility Policy) Rules, 2014 and such other rules, regulations, circulars, and notifications (collectively referred hereinafter as 'Regulations') as may be applicable and as amended from time to time and will, inter-alia, provide for the following:

- Establishing a guideline in compliance with the statutory provisions to dedicate a percentage of the Company's profits for social projects.
- Ensuring the implementation of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives in letter and spirit through appropriate procedures and reporting.
- Creating opportunities for employees to participate in socially responsible initiatives.

CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY COMMITTEE

The Company shall constitute the CSR Committee as and when it exceeds the limit as mentioned under section 135(9) of the Companies Act, 2023 and till such time the Board of Directors shall discharge the functions of the Committee. The Board shall primarily be responsible for undertaking, implementing and reviewing CSR Projects. The Company recognizes its responsibility towards communities, customers and business partners.

The responsibilities of the Board are as under

CSR Funds

The corpus for the purpose of carrying on the aforesaid activities would include the followings:

- Surplus, if any, arising out of CSR activities carried out by the company will be further used in development of the CSR projects and such surplus will not be part of business profit of the company.

CSR BUDGET

The total budget for the CSR projects will be decided by the Board.

IMPLEMENTATION:

The Company shall undertake CSR Projects which are closely linked with the principles of sustainable development and shared value, with involvement of local institutions and the community at large.

The CSR Team would assist in implementation and monitoring of the CSR projects / initiatives. The actual implementation of various initiatives would be broad-based with the involvement of various employees/units or through implementing agencies like NGOs, Trusts, Societies, Section 8 / Section 25 companies or through collaborative projects with other corporate.

DISBURSEMENT:

The disbursement of funds for CSR activity / programme / project will be in one or more tranche depending upon the nature and requirement of project. The terms, conditions and timing of disbursement will be with the approval of CSR Committee after due discussion with the CSR Core Team.
